Just last year, Chinese travel platform Mafengwo was accused of fabricating as much as 85% of reviews on its platform. However, the company hit back claiming that the reviews in question only accounted for 3% of the user-generated content that the website offers. According to a recent transparency report, TripAdvisor prevented over 1 million fake reviews from appearing on its website in 2018.

"The fake review market is only expanding and rapidly finding new ways to exploit review platforms," says Saoud Khalifah, founder and CEO of Fakespot - a review-analysis website that uses technology to detect fake reviews. "Fakespot has analysed over 5 billion reviews to date. We estimate that around 30% of

the reviews are unreliable on major platforms such as Amazon."

According to Khalifah, in the majority of cases, it's companies trying to pump

up their own products by engaging in fake review marketing campaigns or positive review injections within their listings to increase their average product rating.
